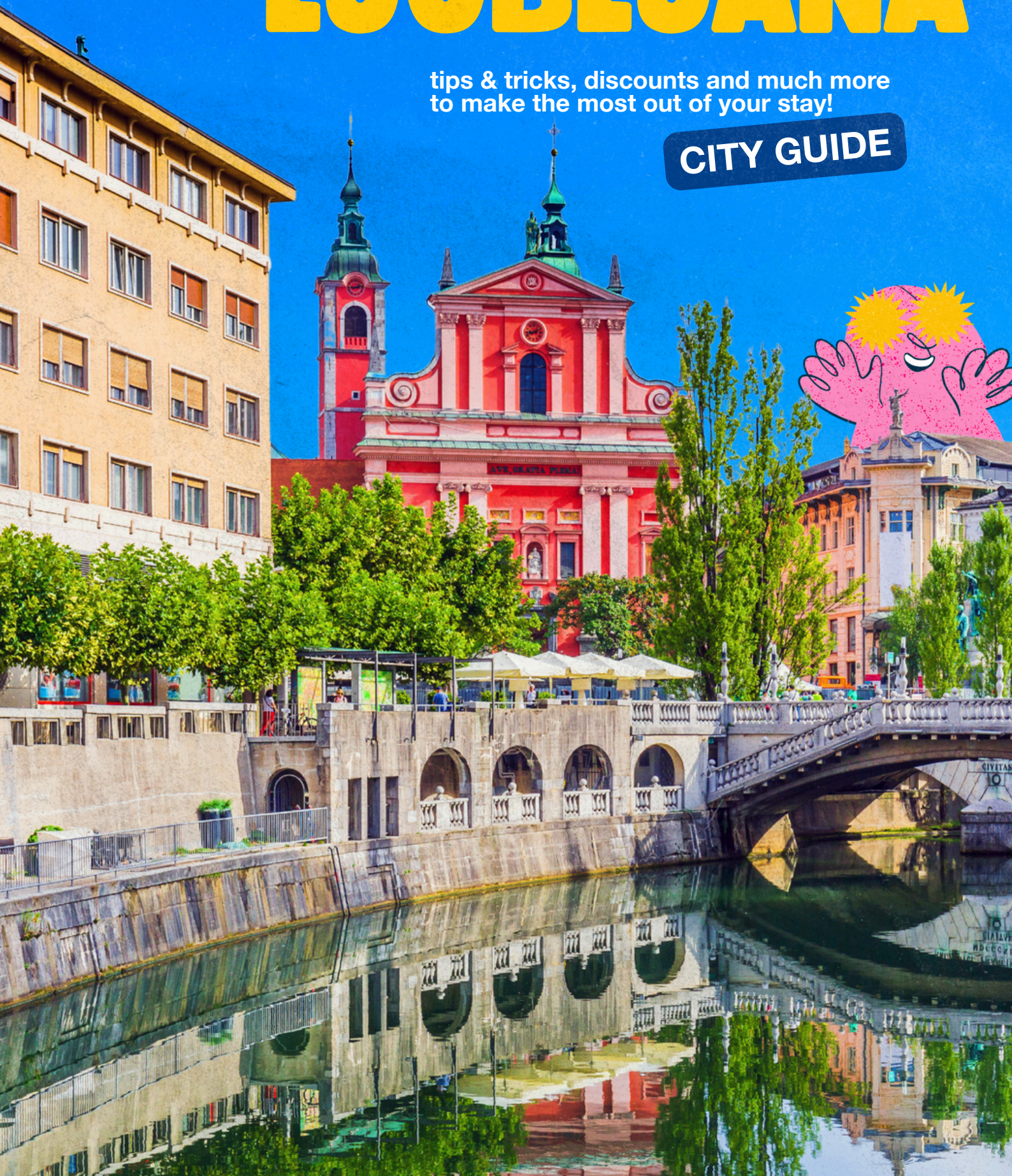

The name “Ljubljana”

The city's name is thought to be derived from the Slavic word "ljubljenja," meaning "beloved," reflecting its charm and appeal.



The river

Ljubljanica river has 7 names, due to the fact that it disappears underground and pops back up loads of times along its journey. People from different regions named it something different, convinced they had stumbled across a brand new river each time.

Starting in the foothills of Mount Snežnik, it first goes by Trbuhovca, then Obrh, followed by Stržen, Rak, Pivka and Unica, before finally resurfacing one last time as the Ljubljanica, where it keeps its most famous name to this very day.

Did anyone say... dragons?

One of Ljubljana's most famous symbols is the dragon. According to legend, the Greek hero Jason and his Argonauts defeated a dragon in the swamps where Ljubljana stands today.

The legend says that, many years ago, a terrifying dragon lived in the swamps around the Ljubljanica River. Anyone who entered the area became easy prey. Then Jason, a Greek hero sailing on the Argo ship with his crew of warriors, arrived during his journey home to Thessaly. After winning the Golden Fleece, he travelled through the Danube, Sava and finally the Ljubljanica river. When Jason reached the swamps near Ljubljana, he fought and defeated the dragon, proving himself worthy of becoming a king. Over time, this settlement developed into the Roman town of Emona in 14 AD, and eventually became modern-day Ljubljana.

A green city

In 2016, Ljubljana was declared European Green Capital by the European Commission. This recognition was due to its rapid sustainability transformation, high environmental standards, and commitment to green urban development, including pedestrianizing its city center and expanding green spaces. Sound like a great destination to explore by foot and bike!

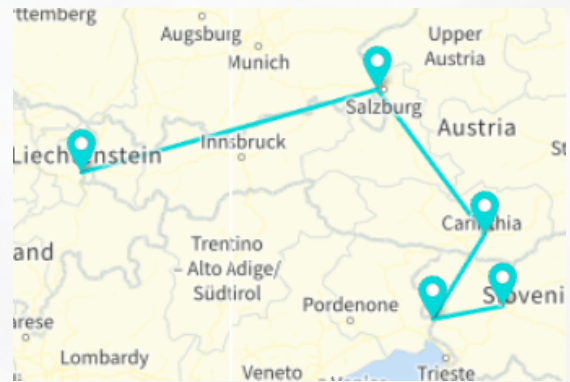
