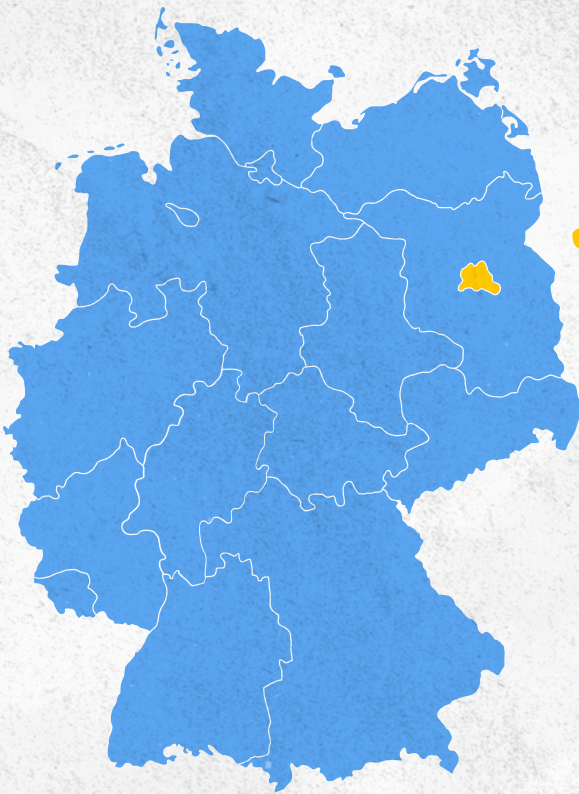

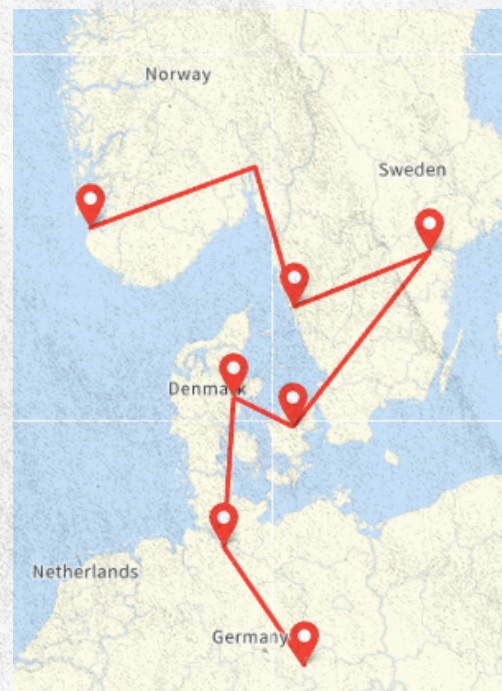
THAT YOU CAN TRAVEL ALONG A CULTURAL ROUTE?

- **Kiez: Neighbourhood**
- **Späti: Late-night shop**
- **Schrippe: Bread roll**
- **Stulle: Sandwich**
- **Bulette: Meatball**
- **JWD (janz weit draußen): Very far away**
- **schnieke: Stylish/pretty**
- **pillepalle: Easy/not important**

TYPICAL PHRASES

- **Nu aba ran an de Buletten!: Let's go/Let's get started!**
- **Bist wohl in de S-Bahn jebor'n?: Close the door!**
- **Da kamma nich meckan: Can't complain**
- **Ick gloob, mein Schwein pfeift!: I can't believe it!**
- **Et is wie't is: It is what it is**
